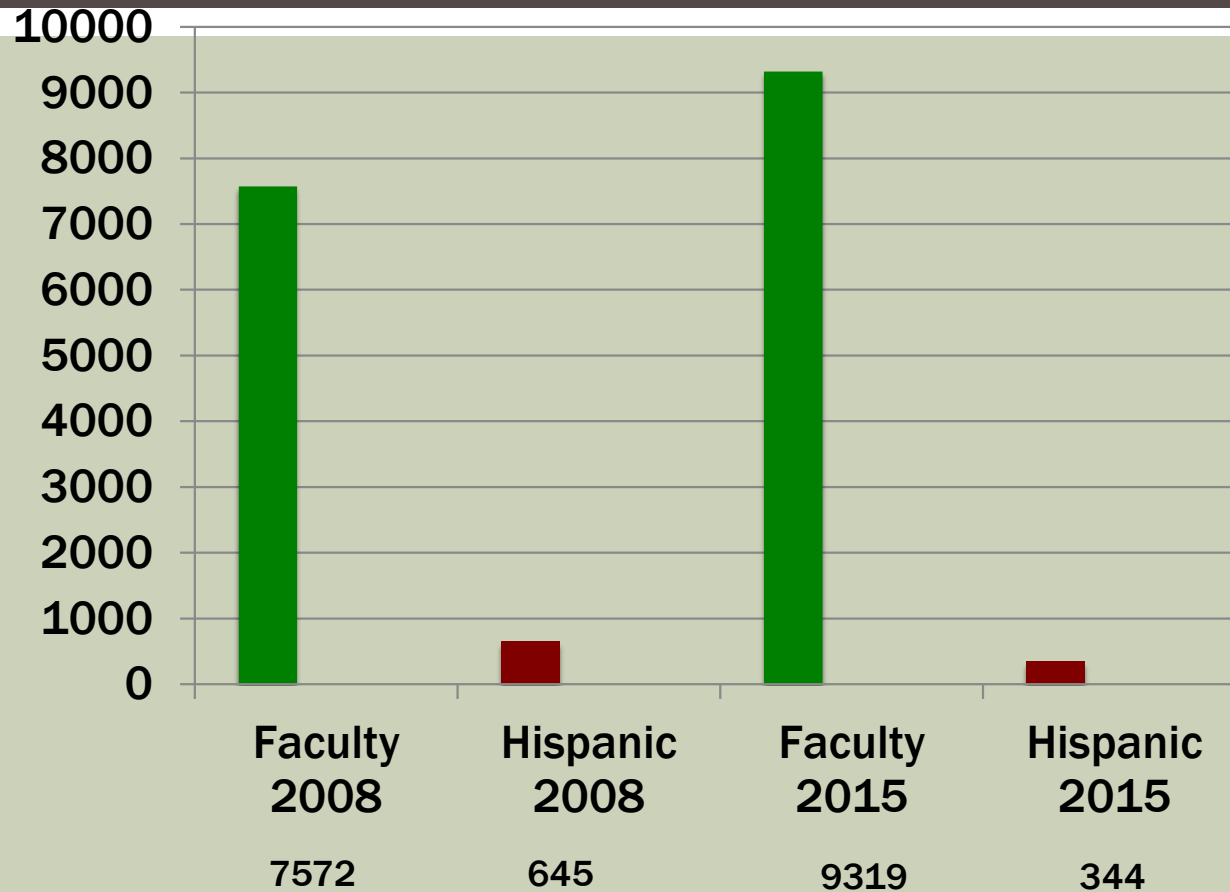
# SOURCE OF DATA

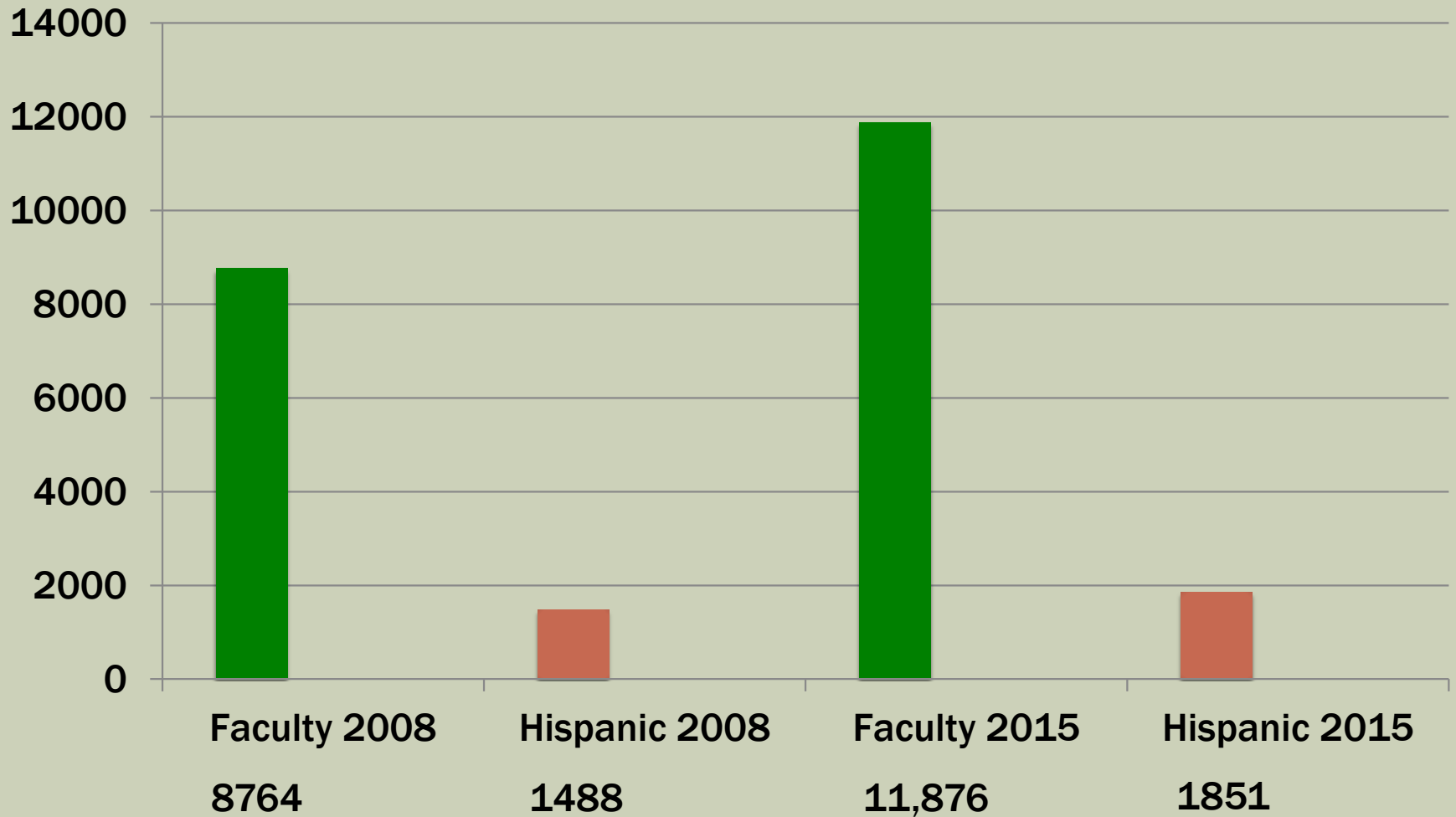
# PROGRESS?

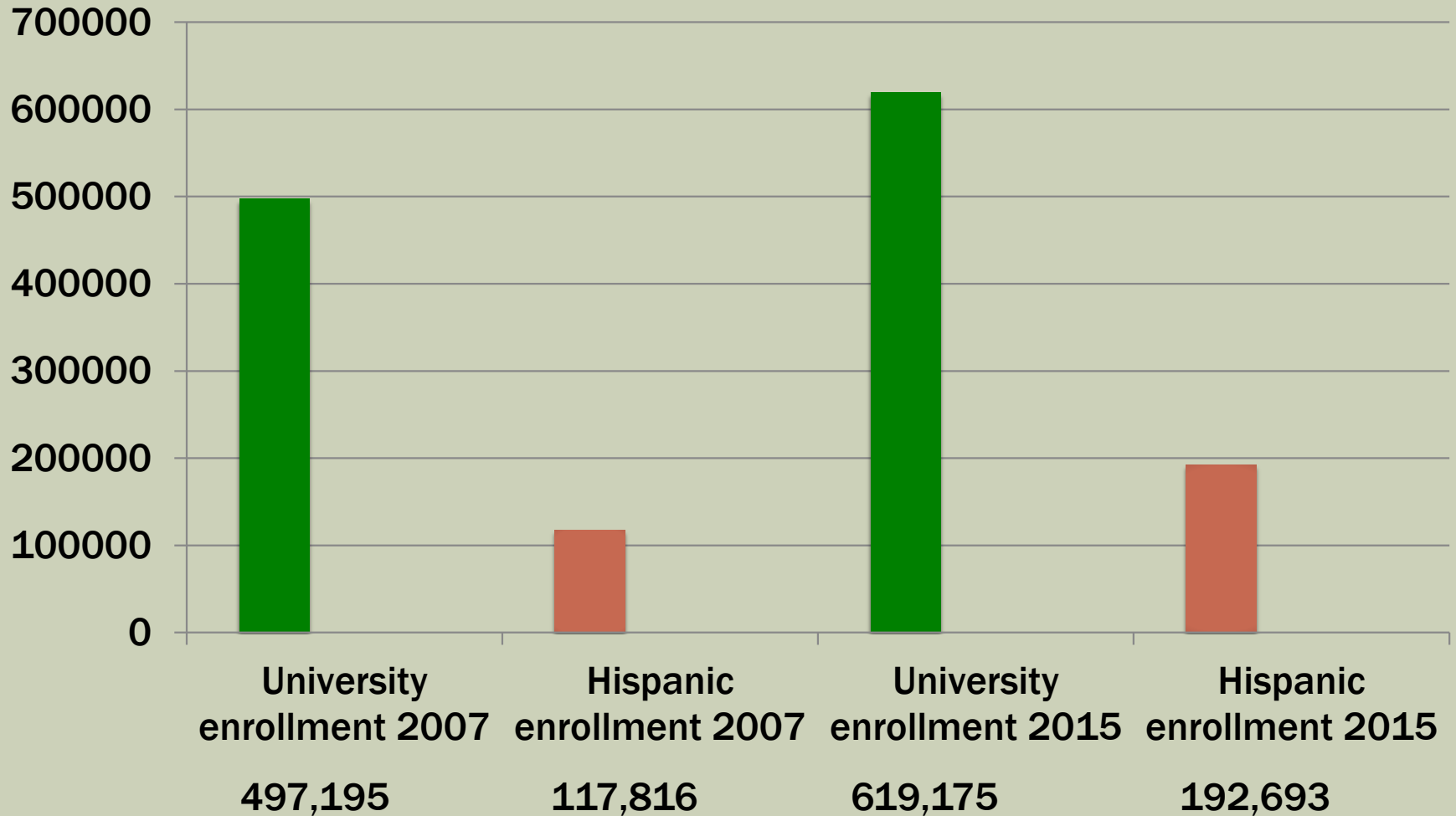
# TENURED FACULTY



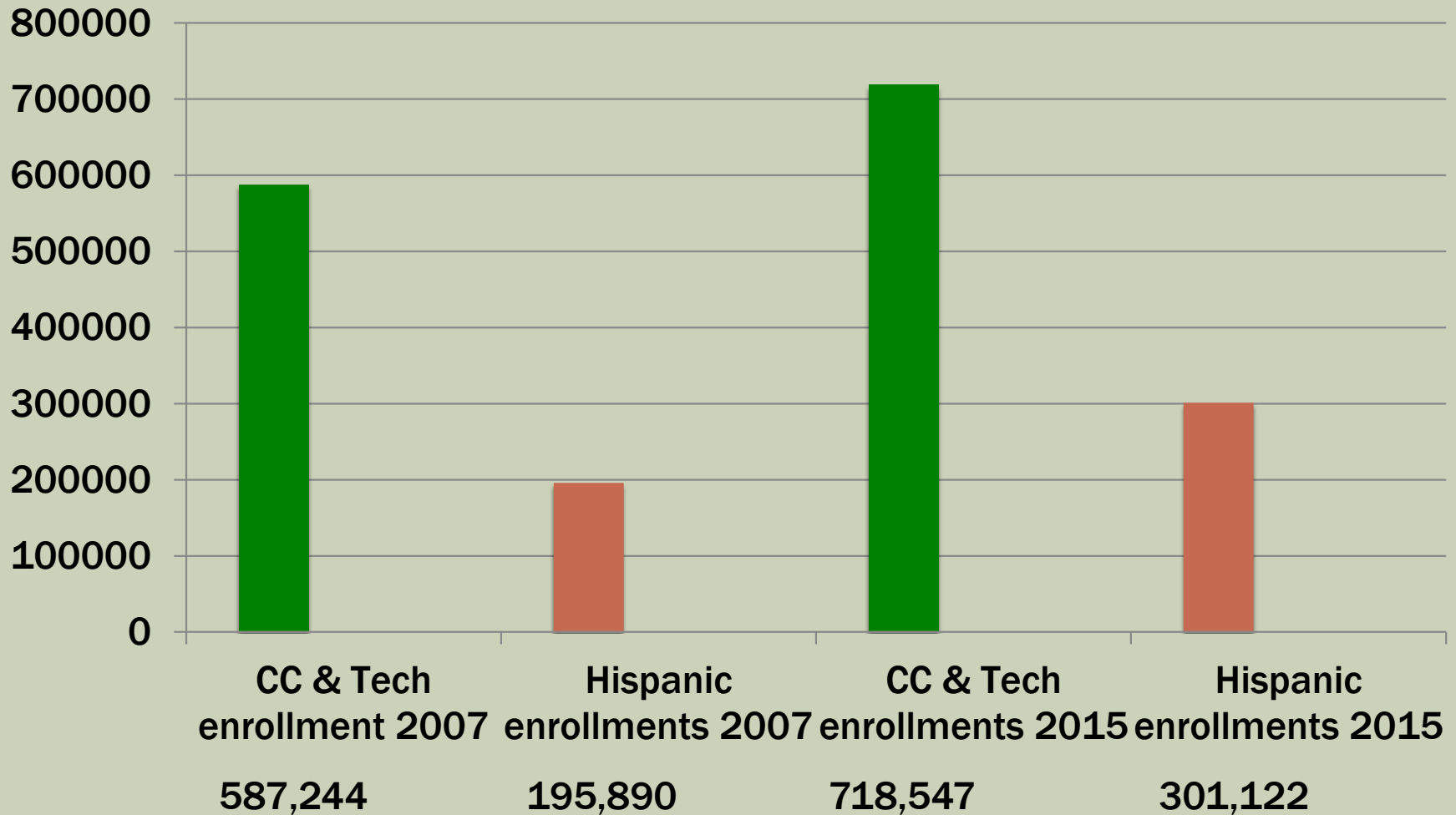
# TEXAS COMMUNITY COLLEGE FULL TIME FACULTY
